## Ordinance No. 2024-02

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ARTICLE 9.0934 OF THE GARRISON MUNICIPAL CODE PROHIBITING VEHICLE TURNS ACROSS TRAFFIC TO PARK ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF THE STREET:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARRISON, MCLEAN COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

## 9.0934 Prohibition on Crossing Double Yellow Lines

- Prohibited Conduct. It shall be unlawful for any driver to:
  - (a) Turn a vehicle across solid double yellow centerlines marked on any city street for the purpose of parking on the other side of the street from which the turn was initiated; or
  - (b) Back a vehicle across solid double yellow centerlines marked on any city street for the purpose of leaving a parking spot to proceed in the direction opposite to the parked position.
- 2. **Exceptions.** The prohibitions in section 1(a) & (b) above shall not apply to:
  - (a) Authorized emergency vehicles responding to an emergency call or engaged in official duties; and
  - (b) Authorized city, public utility, or other government vehicles when required for official duties.
- Visibility of Markings. The prohibitions set forth in Section 1 apply regardless of whether the solid double yellow centerlines are visible, obscured by snow, ice, or other conditions.
- 4. **Penalties.** Any person who violates Section 1 shall be guilty of an infraction and subject to a fine of \$100 for each offense.
- Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect and is in force from and after its publication as required by law. Upon its effective date, all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
